Zorgvliet Cap Classique

The grapes were crushed and destemmed. Only the cuvee fraction (first 550L/ton) was used from the press. Juice was cold settled and then fermented with a neutral yeast strain in old French oak barrels. After 3 months barrel aging on the yeast lees the wine was moved to tank and prepared for bottling. The wine spent a further 12 months in the bottle on the secondary fermentation lees before disgorgement.

Zorgvliet Semillon

Semillon grapes are known for their thin skin and susceptibility to various vineyard influences, such as terroir and climate.

When harvested early, Semillon wines tend to be light, crisp, and citrusy, making them perfect for fresh and zesty white wines. As the grapes ripen further, they can develop more

complex flavors, including notes of honey, beeswax, and even hints of lanolin.

Zorgvliet Single Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc

The 3.2 ha block is situated on a steeply terraced South facing slope. The scion clone is Clone 11 (weerstasie) known for acid retention and expression of greener flavours. The elevation is 350m – this provides for moderate temperatures resulting in late, but slow ripening of fruit.

Zorgvliet Cabernet Franc Rosé

The grapes were de-stemmed and lightly crushed. The juice was immediately pressed, (only the lightest pressings are used) and cold settled for 2 days at 8°C. Thereafter the clear juice was racked off its gross lees and transferred to stainless tank for fermentation. A delicate and dry rose' to accompany you on hot summers days. As the wine matures, it will develop more creaminess on the palate.

Zorgvliet Merlot

The Merlot on Zorgvliet grows in shallow duplex soils that contains a dense layer of clay in the subsoil. This leads to concentration and causes this wine to often be mistaken for its heavier brother - Cabernet Sauvignon. The nose reminds of black cherry, plum and sandalwood, with a hint of boegoe. The entry in the mouth is smooth with good dark chocolate focus on the mid palate and a somewhat dryish finish. There is a tight midpalate focus. The wine is full bodied and rich and will reward some aging.

Zorgvliet Cabernet Franc

Few wards in South Africa that can ripen Cabernet Franc properly like we do in the Banghoek Valley. Overripe and it becomes jammy - under ripe and it becomes herbaceous and vegetal. We use grapes from a single vineyard to create this delicate and harmonious wine. The wine has good length and richness right through to the finish. A dryish but lengthy finish.

Zorgvliet Petit Verdot

What sets Petit Verdot apart is its bold structure, marked by high acidity and substantial tannins. This gives the wine excellent aging potential, allowing it to mellow and develop complexity over time. When young, Petit Verdot wines can be quite powerful and may benefit from some aging to soften their edges and reveal their full potential.
